Mediterranean Chicken Pasta with Olives, Sweet Peppers & Onions

2 Servings

Sweet bell peppers and silky caramelized onions unite with the almighty Kalamata olive for a delightful sweet and salty effect. Boneless, skinless chicken breasts are tossed in there too for a protein-rich pasta dinner that comes together in no time. All aboard! We've...

WHAT WE SEND

- boneless, skinless chicken breasts
- red bell pepper
- yellow onion

WHAT YOU NEED

- all-purpose flour ¹
- coarse kosher salt
- freshly ground pepper
- olive oil

TOOLS

- colander
- large skillet

1. Prep vegetables & olives

Bring a large pot of **salted water** to a boil. Trim ends from **onion**, then halve, peel, and thinly slice lengthwise (about **2 cups**). Halve **pepper**, remove stem and seeds, then thinly slice. Coarsely chop **olives**, removing any pits if necessary.



2. Prep chicken

Pat **chicken** dry; cut crosswise into ¼-inch strips. In a medium bowl, toss chicken with **1 teaspoon oil** and ¼ **teaspoon each salt and pepper**.



3. Brown onions

Heat **1 tablespoon oil** in a medium skillet over medium-high. Add **onions**. Cook, stirring occasionally, until beginning to brown, about 5 minutes. Add **peppers** and ¼ **teaspoon each salt and pepper**. Reduce heat to medium. Cook until peppers are very soft, 8-10 minutes.



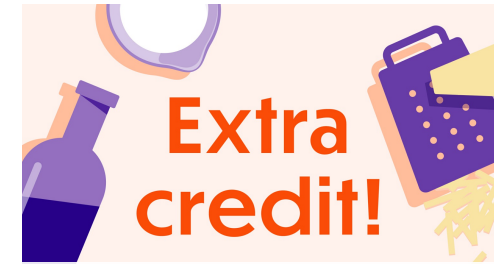
4. Cook pasta

Meanwhile, add **pasta** to boiling water. Cook until al dente, about 9 minutes. Reserve ¼ **cup pasta cooking water**, then drain and return pasta to empty pot.



5. Add chicken & olives

Add **chicken** and ½ of the **olives** to skillet with veggies. Cook until opaque, 2-3 minutes. Stir in **1 tablespoon flour** to coat. Add **pasta water**; cook until liquid is reduced by ½ and chicken is cooked through, 2-3 minutes. Season to taste with **salt and pepper**. Add to pasta and toss to combine. Serve topped with **remaining olives**; drizzle with **olive oil**. Enjoy!



6. Spice it up!

Add a hit of crushed red chili flakes for those that like a little heat. Or grate Parmesan over the top for the cheese lovers.
