Sesame-Scallion Turkey Stir-Fry

with Chinese Egg Noodles

Picture a big, beautiful bowl of slippery noodles, and all the endless possibilities. There are so many ways to enjoy one of our favorite carbs, but tonight we're keeping it simple with juicy ground turkey and a real winner of a sauce: fragrant scallions and garlic with tamari soy sauce and a sprinkle of sesame seeds. We've got you covered!

WHAT WE SEND

- 2 scallions
- 2 (2½ oz) Chinese egg noodles ^{1,2}
- 1 pkt crushed red pepper
- \cdot 2 oz tamari soy sauce ³
- 10 oz pkg ground turkey
- ¼ oz pkt toasted sesame seeds ⁴

WHAT YOU NEED

- kosher salt & ground pepper
- garlic
- neutral oil
- apple cider vinegar (or white wine vinegar)
- sugar

TOOLS

- medium pot
- medium nonstick skillet

ALLERGENS

Egg (1), Wheat (2), Soy (3), Sesame (4). May contain traces of other allergens. Packaged in a facility that packages gluten containing products.

1. Prep ingredients

Bring a medium pot of **water** to a boil over high.

Finely chop **2 teaspoons garlic**. Trim ends from **scallions**, then thinly slice.

Add **noodles** to boiling water. Cook, stirring occasionally to prevent sticking, until al dente, 4–5 minutes. Drain; set aside for step 4.



4. Add noodles & sauce

To skillet with **turkey**, add **noodles** and **scallion sauce**; cook over medium heat, tossing until heated through, about 1 minutes. Season to taste with **salt** and **pepper**.



2. Make sauce

Meanwhile, heat 2 tablespoons oil in a medium nonstick skillet over mediumhigh. Add scallions, garlic, and red pepper flakes (use less depending on heat preference); cook, stirring, until sizzling and fragrant, and scallions are bright green, 2–3 minutes. Transfer to a small bowl; stir in tamari, 2 tablespoons water, 1 tablespoon vinegar, and 2 teaspoons sugar; set aside.



3. TURKEY VARIATION

Heat **1 tablespoon oil** in same skillet over high. Add **ground turkey** and break into large pieces with a spoon. Season with **salt** and **pepper**. Cook, without stirring, until well browned on one side, 4–5 minutes. Stir, then continue to cook until just cooked through, about 3 minutes more. Drain excess oil, if desired.



5. Serve

Serve turkey and Chinese egg noodle stirfry with sesame seeds sprinkled over top. Enjoy!



6. Add some greens

Quickly steam some broccoli florets to toss in with the noodles and turkey. You can also use snow peas, green beans, or any other veggies you have lying around!
