BBQ Chicken Sandwich

with Ranch Slaw

WHAT WE SEND

- 1 pkt ranch dressing 1,2
- ¼ oz granulated garlic
- · 14 oz cabbage blend
- ½ lb pkg chicken breast strips
- · 2 oz barbecue sauce
- 2 artisan buns 1,2,3,4

WHAT YOU NEED

- · neutral oil
- apple cider vinegar (or white wine vinegar)
- sugar
- kosher salt & ground pepper

TOOLS

· medium nonstick skillet

ALLERGENS

1. Make slaw

Preheat broiler with a rack in the top position.

In a large bowl, whisk to combine ranch dressing, 1 tablespoon each of water and oil, 1 teaspoon vinegar, ¼ teaspoon granulated garlic, and ¼ teaspoon sugar. Add cabbage blend and toss to coat. Season to taste with salt and pepper; set aside to soften until step 4.



2. Cook chicken

Pat chicken dry, then season all over with salt and pepper. Heat 1 tablespoon oil in a medium nonstick skillet over mediumhigh. Add chicken and cook until well browned and cooked through, 2–3 minutes per side. Transfer to a cutting board and wipe out skillet.

Once cool enough to handle, use your fingers or 2 forks to pull apart and shred chicken.



3. Finish chicken

Heat 1 tablespoon oil in same skillet over medium. Add barbecue sauce, ¼ teaspoon granulated garlic, and shredded chicken; cook, stirring, until chicken is coated in sauce and warmed through, about 30 seconds. Season to taste with salt and pepper.



4. Finish & serve

Place **buns**, cut-sides down, directly on top oven rack; broil until toasted and lightly browned, 1–2 minutes (watch closely as broilers vary). Divide **barbecue chicken** between buns and top with **some of the slaw**.

Serve BBQ chicken sandwich with remaining slaw alongside. Enjoy!
