



## Seared Chicken & Apple-Shallot Pan Sauce

over Mashed Sweet Potatoes with Spinach Salad

There is nothing more comforting than a home-cooked meal—especially when it includes pan-roasted chicken breasts and creamy mashed sweet potatoes. We up the flavor factor with a sweet and savory apple-shallot pan sauce and baby spinach salad studded with crunchy pecans. This is for sure a winner-winner chicken dinner.



## What we send

- 1 sweet potato
- 1 shallot
- 1 Granny Smith apple
- 12 oz pkg boneless, skinless chicken breasts
- ¼ oz poultry seasoning
- 1 pkt turkey broth concentrate
- ¼ oz Dijon mustard
- 1 oz pecans <sup>15</sup>
- 2 (1 oz) sour cream <sup>7</sup>
- 5 oz baby spinach

## What you need

- kosher salt & pepper
- olive oil
- apple cider vinegar (or red wine vinegar)
- all-purpose flour (or gluten-free alternative)
- butter <sup>7</sup>

## Tools

- small saucepan
- medium skillet

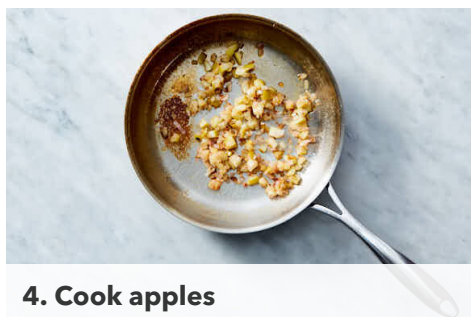


## THIS IS A CUSTOMIZED RECIPE STEP

### 1. Cook sweet potatoes

Peel **sweet potato**, then cut into 1-inch pieces. Place sweet potatoes in a small saucepan. Add enough **salted water** to cover by 1-inch. Bring to a boil, then simmer until tender, about 15 minutes. Drain, return to pot and cover to keep warm.



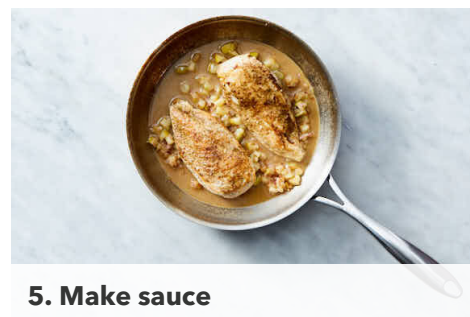
### 4. Cook apples

Melt **1 tablespoon butter** in same skillet over medium-high heat. Add **apples** and **remaining shallots**; cook, stirring occasionally, until well browned and slightly softened, 3-5 minutes. Stir in **1 teaspoon flour** and cook, about 30 seconds.



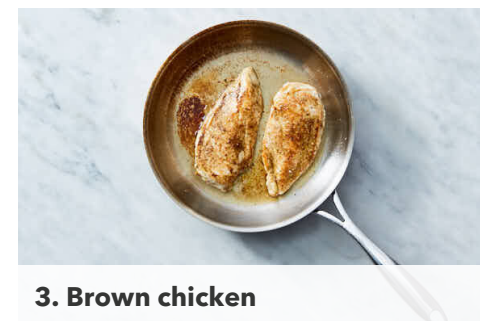
### 2. Prep ingredients

Finely chop **shallot**. Remove core from **apple**, then cut half into ¼-inch cubes (save rest for own use). Pat **chicken** dry; season all over with **salt, pepper**, and **1 teaspoon poultry seasoning**. In a medium bowl, whisk together **2 tablespoons oil** and **1 tablespoon each of the vinegar and of the chopped shallots**; set dressing aside until step 6.



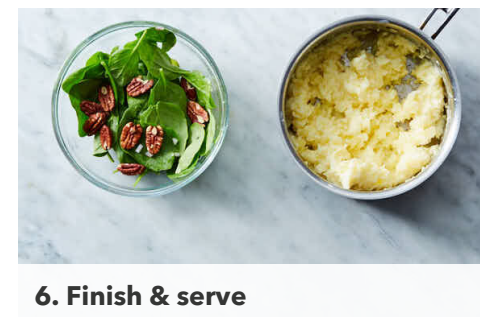
### 5. Make sauce

To same skillet, add **turkey broth concentrate**, **1 teaspoon Dijon**, and **1 cup water**; bring to a simmer, scraping up any browned bits at bottom. Return **chicken** to skillet and continue to simmer over medium-low heat until chicken is cooked through, **apples** are tender, and **sauce** is thickened, 5-7 minutes.



### 3. Brown chicken

Heat **1 tablespoon oil** in a medium skillet over medium-high. Add **chicken** and cook until well browned on both sides but not cooked through, 2-3 minutes per side. Transfer chicken to a plate.



### 6. Finish & serve

Toast **pecans**, if desired. Return saucepan with **sweet potatoes** to medium-high; add **sour cream** and **2 tablespoons butter**. Coarsely mash using a fork or potato masher. Season to taste with **salt** and **pepper**. Toss **spinach** and **pecans** with **dressing**. Serve **chicken** with **apples** and **sauce** spooned over top, and with **mashed potatoes** and **salad** alongside. Enjoy!
