## **Chinese Pepper Beef**

with Steamed Jasmine Rice

The trick to a tasty stir-fry is a flavorful sauce. Here, our sweet and savory stir-fry sauce mingles with tender beef strips, mushrooms, bell peppers, and onions. This quick stir-fry channels all our favorite characteristics of a take-out style dish but with a fresh, homemade twist.

#### What we send

- 5 oz jasmine rice
- 1 yellow onion
- garlic
- 1 bell pepper
- 4 oz mushrooms
- ¼ oz fresh cilantro
- 10 oz pkg beef strips
- 3 oz stir-fry sauce 1,2

#### What you need

- kosher salt & ground pepper
- neutral oil

#### Tools

- small saucepan
- medium nonstick skillet

#### Allergens

### 1. Cook rice

In a small saucepan, combine **rice**, **1**<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> **cups water**, and <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> **teaspoon salt**, bring to a boil. Cover and cook over low heat until rice is tender and water is absorbed, about 17 minutes. Keep covered until ready to serve.



2. Prep ingredients

Cut **onion** into ½-inch pieces. Finely chop **1 teaspoon garlic**.

Halve **pepper**, discard stem and seeds, then cut into ½-inch pieces. Thinly slice **mushrooms**.

Coarsely chop **cilantro leaves and stems** together.



3. Cook beef

Pat **beef** dry.

Heat **1 tablespoon oil** in a medium nonstick skillet over medium-high. Add beef and cook until well browned on the bottom, about 3 minutes (it won't be cooked through). Transfer to a plate.



4. Cook mushrooms

Heat **1 tablespoon oil** in same skillet over medium-high. Add **mushrooms** and cook, stirring, until golden brown and liquid is absorbed, 3-5 minutes. Season with **a pinch each of salt and pepper**. Transfer to plate with **beef**.



5. Cook onions & peppers

Heat **1 tablespoon oil** in same skillet over medium-high. Add **peppers**, **onions**, and **a pinch each of salt and pepper**. Cook, covered, until softened and lightly browned, 4–5 minutes. Stir in **chopped garlic**.



6. Finish & serve

Return **beef** and **mushrooms** to skillet along with **stir-fry sauce** and **¼ cup water**. Bring to a simmer; cook, stirring occasionally, until sauce is slightly thickened and meat is cooked through, 1-2 minutes. Season to taste with **salt** and **pepper**. Fluff **rice** with a fork.

Serve **stir-fry** over **rice** with **cilantro** sprinkled on top. Enjoy!
