# **Beef Tostadas** with Tomato Salsa & Crema



We love eating without utensils. And the best thing about tostadas? The tortillas get so crispy that they basically become mini shovels so you can inhale each delicious bite. The ground beef is mixed with a taco seasoning blend, then piled high with tomato salsa, crema, and scallion greens. We've got you covered!

## **WHAT WE SEND**

- · 2 scallions
- 2 plum tomatoes
- · 2 (1 oz) sour cream 1
- · 6 (6-inch) corn tortillas
- 10 oz pkg grass-fed ground beef
- ¼ oz taco seasoning

#### WHAT YOU NEED

- garlic
- neutral oil
- kosher salt & ground pepper

#### **TOOLS**

- · rimmed baking sheet
- medium skillet

# 1. Prep garlic & scallions

Preheat oven to 425°F with a rack in the center.

Finely chop 1 teaspoon garlic.

Trim ends from **scallions**, then thinly slice, keeping dark greens separate.



# 2. Make salsa & crema

Chop tomatoes into ¼-inch pieces. In a small bowl, toss to combine with ¼ of the chopped garlic and 1 teaspoon oil. Season to taste with salt and pepper.

In a second small bowl, thin **all of the sour cream** by stirring in **1 teaspoon water** at a time until it drizzles from a spoon; season to taste with **salt** and **pepper**. Set **salsa** and **crema** aside for step 5.



## 3. Bake tortillas

Lightly brush both sides of **tortillas** with **oil**. Transfer to a rimmed baking sheet and arrange in an even layer (it's okay if they overlap slightly). Bake on center oven rack until golden and crisp, flipping halfway through cooking time, 9–12 minutes (watch closely as ovens vary).



4. Cook beef

Heat 2 teaspoons oil in a medium skillet over medium-high. Add beef and season with salt. Cook, breaking up into smaller pieces, until no longer pink, 2–3 minutes. Add scallion whites and light greens, remaining garlic, and 2½ teaspoons taco seasoning; cook until fragrant, about 1 minute. Add ½ cup water; cook until almost evaporated and beef is cooked through, 1–2 minutes.



5. Assemble tostadas & serve

Season beef to taste with salt and pepper. Divide among crispy tortillas, then top with salsa.

Serve **beef tostadas** with **crema** drizzled over top and sprinkled with **scallion dark greens**. Enjoy!



6. Spice it up!

Add fresh or pickled jalapeño slices into the beef in step 4 for a spiced up take on tostadas.
