Grilled Tikka-Spiced Ribeye Pork Chop

with Yogurt Cucumber Salad

We can't resist the smoky char of a grilled pork chop! We quickly marinate ribeye pork chops in Greek yogurt with fresh ginger, garlic, and garam masala spice blend—which flavors the meat and makes the pork juicy and tender. Aromatic rice and a creamy cucumber salad round out this flavorful dinner. Don't forget a sprinkle of fresh cilantro and a squeeze of lime on top!

What we send

- 5 oz jasmine rice
- garlic
- 1 lime
- 1 piece fresh ginger
- ¼ oz fresh cilantro
- ¼ oz garam masala
- 4 oz Greek yogurt ¹
- 12 oz pkg ribeye pork chop
- 1 cucumber

What you need

- kosher salt & ground pepper
- · olive oil
- red wine vinegar (or white wine vinegar)

Tools

- grill or grill pan
- medium saucepan
- microplane or grater

Cooking tip

No grill or grill pan? Heat 1 tablespoon oil in a skillet over medium-high. Add pork and cook until lightly charred on both sides and cooked through, 3-4 minutes per side.

1. Make rice

Preheat a grill on high, if using.

In a medium saucepan, combine **rice**, **1**% **cups water**, and % **teaspoon salt**; bring to a boil. Cover and cook over low until rice is tender and **water** is absorbed, about 17 minutes. Keep covered until ready to serve.



2. Prep ingredients

Meanwhile, finely chop **2 teaspoons** garlic. Finely grate all of the lime zest, then cut lime into wedges. Peel and finely chop **2 teaspoons ginger**. Pick cilantro leaves from stems; reserve whole leaves for step 6 and finely chop stems.



3. Marinate pork

Happy cooking!

In a medium bowl, stir to combine all of the garam masala, chopped ginger, half of the Greek yogurt, 2 tablespoons oil, and 1 teaspoon of the chopped garlic.

Pat **pork** dry and season all over with **salt** and **pepper**; add to bowl with yogurt marinade and toss to combine. Set aside to marinate until step 5.



4. Make cucumber salad

Peel **cucumber**, use a spoon to scoop out seeds, then thinly slice on an angle.

In a medium bowl, stir to combine cucumbers, chopped cilantro stems, remaining yogurt and chopped garlic, 1 tablespoon water, and 1 teaspoon vinegar. Season to taste with salt and pepper. Set cucumber salad aside until step 6.



5. Cook pork chop

Heat a grill pan over medium-high, if using.

Remove **any excess marinade** from **pork**, then transfer to grill or grill pan. Cook until browned and cooked through, 3-4 minutes per side. Transfer to a cutting board to rest.



6. Finish rice & serve

Fluff rice with a fork, then stir in lime zest. Slice pork into strips and serve over rice, with cucumber salad alongside. Garnish with reserved whole cilantro leaves and lime wedges for squeezing over, if desired. Enjoy!
