Buffalo Fried Chicken Tacos

with Ranch Dressing

Dinner needs to be on the table ASAP. Do you A) Order take-out for the umpteenth time? Or B) Make these Buffalo fried chicken tacos? Personally, we'd choose B. This dish requires absolutely no prepwork—just bread and fry the chicken, wrap them up in lettuce and tortillas, and stir together a parmesan ranch dressing. So put your knife away and enjoy your Dinnerly without the stress or mess! We've got you covered!

WHAT WE SEND

- ½ lb pkg chicken breast strips
- 1 romaine heart
- ³⁄₄ oz Parmesan ²
- + 2 pkts ranch dressing $^{\rm 1,2}$
- 6 (6-inch) flour tortillas 3,4
- 1 oz Buffalo sauce

WHAT YOU NEED

- kosher salt & ground pepper, to taste
- all-purpose flour ⁴
- 1 large egg¹
- neutral oil
- butter ²

TOOLS

- medium skillet
- microwave

COOKING TIP

When frying, make sure your oil is hot: it should reach 350°F with an oil thermometer. Or drop a pinch of flour into the oil—it should sizzle vigorously. Careful, oil may splatter while frying!

ALLERGENS

1. Prep ingredients

Pat chicken very dry; season all over with salt and pepper. Toss with 1 tablespoon flour until evenly coated.

Pull apart **lettuce leaves** and tear into smaller pieces; discard end.

In a small bowl, mix **parmesan** and **1 tablespoon water**. Stir in **all of the ranch dressing**; set aside for serving.



4. Finish & serve

Stack **tortillas** and wrap in a damp paper towel; microwave until warmed through, 30 seconds at a time. In a medium bowl, microwave **Buffalo sauce** and **2 tablespoons butter** until butter is melted; stir to combine. Add **chicken** and toss to combine.

Divide Buffalo chicken and lettuce between tortillas and drizzle with ranch dressing. Enjoy!



2. Bread chicken

In a shallow bowl, whisk together **1 large** egg and **1 tablespoon water**.

In a large resealable plastic bag, add ½ cup flour.

Dip **chicken** in egg, letting excess drip back into bowl. Add to bag with flour and shake to coat; transfer to a plate.

3. Fry chicken

Heat ¼-inch oil in a medium skillet over medium-high until shimmering. Working in batches if necessary, add chicken in a single layer (careful, oil may splatter). Cook until golden-brown, about 2 minutes per side (see cooking tip!). Transfer to a paper towel-lined plate; lightly blot excess oil. Lightly season with salt and pepper.
