Toasted Coconut Chia Overnight Oats with Apricots & Almonds





It's early in the morning, and you're too groggy to make a proper breakfast. Another bowl of cereal? Microwave oatmeal perhaps? Then you open the fridge and see this: a jar of creamy oats and chia seeds topped with toasted coconut flakes, crunchy almonds, and sweet dried apricots. Your past self was looking out for you, and they were happy to do it since these overnight oats took minutes to make. We've got you covered!

WHAT WE SEND

- 1 oz unsweetened shredded coconut ¹⁵
- 2 oz dried apricots ¹⁷
- 1 oz salted almonds 15
- · 2 (1/4 oz) chia seeds
- 3 oz oats
- 13.5 oz can coconut milk 15
- · 1 oz maple syrup

WHAT YOU NEED

kosher salt

TOOLS

- · rimmed baking sheet
- 2 (8 oz) jars or containers with lids

1. Prep toppings

Preheat oven to 350°F with a rack in the center.

On a rimmed baking sheet, spread coconut in an even layer. Toast on center oven rack until lightly golden-brown and fragrant, stirring halfway through cooking time, 4–6 minutes. Let cool to room temperature until ready to serve.

Coarsely chop **apricots** and **almonds**; set aside until ready to serve.



2. Prep oats & refrigerate

In a medium bowl, combine all of the chia seeds, oats, coconut milk, maple syrup, and ¼ teaspoon salt; stir well to combine. Divide between 2 (8 oz) jars or containers. Cover with lids (or plastic wrap) and refrigerate overnight.



3. Assemble & serve

When ready to serve, stir overnight oats and thin with 1 tablespoon water at a time, as desired. Top with apricots, almonds, and toasted coconut flakes. Enjoy!
