One-Pot Tortelloni Florentine:

Easy Clean Up!

WHAT WE SEND

- garlic
- 9 oz cheese tortelloni 1,3,7
- · 8 oz can tomato sauce
- ¼ oz pizza spice blend
- · 3 oz baby spinach
- 2 oz shredded fontina ⁷

WHAT YOU NEED

- olive oil
- sugar
- kosher salt & ground pepper

TOOLS

· medium ovenproof skillet

ALLERGENS

1. Prep & cook tortelloni

Finely chop 2 teaspoons garlic.

Heat 2 tablespoons oil in a medium ovenproof skillet over medium-high. Add tortelloni in a nearly even layer; cook, without stirring, until golden-brown on the bottom, 2–3 minutes. Carefully add ½ cup water, then immediately cover. Cook until tender, about 5 minutes (reduce heat if browning too quickly). Transfer to a plate; wipe out skillet.



2. Cook marinara sauce

Heat chopped garlic and 1 tablespoon oil in same skillet over medium-high. Cook, stirring, until fragrant, about 1 minute. Stir in tomato sauce, ½ cup water, 1 teaspoon pizza spice, and ½ teaspoon sugar; bring to a boil. Season to taste with salt and pepper. Reduce heat to medium-low and simmer until slightly reduced, about 5 minutes.



3. Add spinach & tortelloni

Preheat broiler with a rack in the top position.

To skillet with marinara sauce, stir in spinach and tortelloni; cook, stirring, until tortelloni are coated and spinach is wilted, 1–2 minutes. Remove from heat; season to taste with salt and pepper.



4. Broil & serve

Top **tortelloni** with **cheese**. Broil on top oven rack until melted and browned in spots, 2–3 minutes (watch closely as broilers vary).

Serve tortelloni florentine garnished with a few grinds of pepper, if desired. Enjoy!
